Where the mind is led forward by thee Into ever-widening thought and action


Into that heaven of freedom, my Father, let my country awake.

CURRENT WORK

STHF is actively involved in arsenic removal systems that provide safe water to over 1300 families in heavily affected villages of Ashok Nagar, West Bengal. New systems were just installed in Simurali of N. 24 Parganas in cooperation with a small for-profit company.
